Called to order at 2pm by Supervisor Radtke with introductions/roll call

Supervisor Radtke informed committee that he and Deputy Supervisor Leedy met with the Interlochen Center for the Arts in hopes for a partnership on a trail from the State Park to the Governmental Complex. ICA was extremely receptive to a partnership arrangement and hope to work with the Township to update the rec plan and work on the trail plan. We are hoping to be successful in our business district sidewalk, which would ultimately connect to the proposed trail.

*Klaus arrived at 2:20pm*

Klaus provided the sketches of Memorial Park that he had provided last March as well as a prefab design for pavilion. Status of the plans for the pavilion in Memorial Park were discussed. Supervisor Radtke inquired to ensure the areas surrounding the pavilion were planned to be ADA compliant with appropriate access to the parking area. Klaus asked ZA Habedank to provide information on location of utilities and infrastructure in Memorial Park. Dpty Svrs Leedy asked Leslie and Klaus to identify their roles, as she is new staff.

Airport Manager Jim Anderson inquired on replacing the posts and installing a fence as a safety separation between the park portion and the airport areas. This would be added to the rec plan.

Recreation plan items to update could include energy efficiencies and added items to Memorial Park, ADA pathways to existing pavilion and new pavilion, bathrooms, governmental center park development (adjoining new library).
